Application Guidelines for Enrollment in April 2022

Entrance Examination of Special Medical Scholarship Programs for International Students

This entrance examination provides scholarships for up to six years to outstanding international students from various countries who wish to study at IUHW School of Medicine. Special scholarship program (FULL or HALF) will be awarded based on academic standards.

Our medical school conducts almost all classes in English until the end of Year 2. However, from Year-3, all classes are conducted in Japanese since you need to cope with clinical training in Japan and to pass the National Examination for Medical Practitioners in Japan.

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Our response to the novel coronavirus in 2022 entrance examination

Regarding the novel coronavirus infectious disease, the situation has been changing day by day and it is difficult to foresee further measures.

Considering this situation, we may take emergency measures to change the examination schedule and selection methods described in this application guideline in the 2022 entrance examination even after the application period.

In addition, we assume that each exam venue must be changed in order to prevent infectious diseases. If each exam venue exceeds its capacity, you might be able to take exams in different venue from where you wished. If we take emergency measures for 2021 entrance examination, we will inform you of that on our website.

1. Details of the "Special Medical Scholarship Programs for International Students"

With the aim of nurturing physicians who can play an active role as leaders in Japan and abroad, we provide Special Medical Scholarship Programs for International Students of the School of Medicine to those who have particularly excellent grades^{*1}. There are two types of Special Medical Scholarship Programs for International Students of the School of Medicine as follows.

X1"Applicants with excellent grades" are those who meet all of the following conditions.

- Those who meet the application criteria listed in "4. Application Requirements (4)" on page 4.
- Those who have enough English or Japanese language ability to take classes at the time of enrollment.
- Those who are expected to have a high enough ability to pass the Japanese National Medical Examination at the time of graduation.

*2 Recipients of the Special Scholarship Program for International Students of the School of Medicine must obtain a medical license, complete the clinical training, and then work as a doctor at a medical institution in Japan or their home country designated by our university for at least the number of years specified in the "Mandatory Training Period" section of the table above.

- X3 If you are selected as a special scholarship international student of the School of Medicine, you will be exempted from the full amount of the admission fee and the fee will be refunded to you after your enrollment in our university (you are required to pay the admission fee during the enrollment procedure period).
- %4 Tuition and other student fees include tuition, practical training fees, and facility and equipment fees.
- %5 Living in the dormitory is optional. If you choose not to live in the dormitory, you will not be provided with dormitory and meal expenses. In addition, you need to pay for utilities and common service fees (3,000 yen/month). Food expenses also will be applied to the cost of meals (breakfast and dinner) provided at the dormitory (if you do not need meals at the dormitory, they will not be paid).

•Continuation of eligibility for the Special Medical Scholarship Programs for International

Students

The scholarship will be terminated when any of the following cases occur.

- ① In case of repeating a year.
- ② In case of receiving disciplinary action designated by IUHW regulations.
- 3 In case of academic performance is deemed to have become extremely poor.
- ④ In case the President of IUHW decides that the continuation of the scholarship is not appropriate.

The schedule and meeting time for the interview will be sent to the e-mail address registered on the online application website at 15:00 on Monday, November 15.

Please note that the dates and meeting times specified by us cannot be changed. If you are unable to take the examination on the designated date and time, you will be deemed to have withdrawn.

•Language used for examinations

- Applicants may choose to take the essay examination in Japanese, English, or both Japanese and English at the time of application. Points will be added if you choose to answer in both Japanese and English and receive a high evaluation.
- You may choose to take the interview in either Japanese or English. However, even if you choose to take the interview in Japanese, some questions and answers will be in English.

•Online Entrance Examination for Overseas Residents Who Have Difficulties Of Coming to Japan Due to

COVID-19

Only applicants residing in countries where entry into Japan is restricted due to COVID-19, and who are unable to come to Japan by the day of the examination, will be allowed to take the examination online via the Internet.

If you live overseas and wish to apply from a country where entry to Japan is restricted, please contact the Admissions Office at least one week before the application period to confirm and discuss the examination environment.

We will provide instructions on how to take the online entrance examination. In addition, please prepare the following internet and system environment in advance.

4. Eligibility

Applicants must meet all of the following requirements (1) - (5).

(1) Applicants must have neither Japanese nationality nor permanent residential status in Japan.

(2) Applicants must meet one of the following requirements (1) - (7)

- (1) Those who have completed a 12-year of school education in a foreign country (including those who are expected to complete it by March 31, 2022), or meet equivalent conditions specified above and designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.
- (2) Those who have graduated or are expected to graduate from an upper secondary school or secondary education school under the School Education Law of Japan in March 2022.
- (3) Those who have completed or are expected to complete a course at an overseas educational institution accredited by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology as having a course equivalent to the course of an upper secondary school or secondary education school by March 31, 2022.
- (4) Those who have obtained or are expected to obtain the International Baccalaureate, the Abitur, the French Baccalaureate and GCE A level, by March 31, 2022.
- (5) Those who have completed or are expected to complete a 12-year of school program at an institution accredited by the international accrediting body (WASC, CIS and ACSI) by March 31, 2022.
- (6) Those who have passed or are expected to pass the Certificate for Students Achieving the Proficiency Level of Upper Secondary School Graduates (including the University Entrance Qualification Examination under the former regulation) based on the upper secondary school or secondary education school equivalency examination regulations, and reach the age of 18 by March 31, 2022.
- (7) Those who have been individually screened by the admission eligibility of our university and have been recognized as having academic abilities equivalent or superior to those of upper secondary school or secondary education school graduates, and reach the age of 18 by March 31, 2022.
- (3) Applicants must have or are expected to have a status of residence that does not interfere with their eligibility for the university admission based on the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act.

(4) Applicants must meet one of the following requirements ① = ③.

① International Baccalaureate degree holders

Applicants must have received the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB Full Diploma) from the International Baccalaureate Organization, a foundation based on the Swiss Civil Code, and must have completed the following courses specified by our university and meet the grade requirements.

X The above conditions are the minimum requirements for application. As a result of the selection process, even if you meet the requirements for a Full scholarship, you may be selected as a Half scholarship student.

② Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students(EJU) Applicants must take the following subjects of the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) administered by the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO), and meet the following subjects and score requirements specified by our university (the date of examination is not specified).

- ③ Applicants, who do not meet the above requirements in ① or ②, but have graduated with excellent grades from a university or graduate school in Japan, or are currently enrolled in a university or graduate school with excellent grades, and have been recognized as having academic abilities equivalent or superior to the above requirements ① or ② in the screening of application qualifications at our university.
 - If you are applying under the above requirements ③, please check the 2. Application
 Qualification Screening below.

(5) Applicants must have an adequate Japanese or English language proficiency to attend classes.

 \cdot The number of times and length of the individual interview may be changed depending on the circumstances.

• You will be asked to wait in the waiting room after the assembly time, and be prohibited to use electronic devices such as mobile phones, smartphones, tablets and personal computers.

7. Tuition Fees

- Please make a payment of tuition fees of first year (admission fee, academic fee, expenses for laboratory trainings, and facility & equipment costs) during the period of enrollment procedures.
- \cdot Students awarded the Special scholarship from IUHW are unable to pay by installments. They must pay in full.
- The admission fee will not be refunded for any reasons. However, if IUHW Special Medical Scholarship for International Students enroll IUHW, they will have a refund for the admissions fee after the enrollment.
- The amount of the Special Medical Scholarship Programs for International Students will be transferred to the student payment of each academic year. The table below shows the amount after the transfer.
- · In addition to the student fees, a reserve fund for overseas clinical training is required.
- X It is necessary to set aside JPY 70,000 every academic year for expenses necessary for overseas clinical experience. "Clinical Clerkship IV" including the overseas clinical training is a compulsory subject.
- · In addition to the fees described above, students need to prepare for expenses such as textbooks, clinical training including transportation, accommodation, immunization, and the alumni party as well as expenses related to the preparation for the national examination for medical practitioners.

2 Select the payment method for the application fee

Select the payment method for the application fee among several options on the screen.

3 Confirm the content you entered and complete your application

Confirm the contents you entered and selected on the confirmation screen, push the button 'Confirm', and proceed to the application confirmation. After completing your application, push the button "Print out".

Attention!

Please make sure to **pay the application fee and send all necessary application materials to the Admissions Office via e-mail** by the due date. Otherwise the application procedure will not be completed.

X <u>IUHW will not refund the application fee</u> even if applicants do not complete their application procedure for the reasons above after paying the application fee.

STEP 4 Print out the application form and other documents (A4 size)

Click on "Print Application Form" on the Application Completion screen to view the PDF file of the application form.

STEP 5 Payment for the Application Fee

Please make a payment for the application fee according to the payment measure you selected at the time of application, and confirm the details of 'payment procedure' which you can print out at the end of the procedure. The entrance examination fees are as follows.

Attention ! Sending application documents by post when you register an additional applications.

If you have registered for Special Medical Scholarship Programs for International Students and have completed STEP 5, Payment of Application Fee, and then registered for the Second Round for Special Entrance Examination for International Students, Please make sure to send all the application documents for each entrance examination category you are applying for. When sending the documents by post, please separate them into separate envelopes. If you only have one original certificate or other document, please consult with the IUHW Admissions Office in advance.

Please be sure to bring the examination voucher on the day of the examination. The examination voucher will be checked at the entrance hall as well as inside the examination room.

•Precautions for taking exam

- Please also make sure to bring the examination voucher when you go outside during the break time. Please be seated at the desk by following the designated examinees number within the entry time of the examination room. Applicants are not allowed to enter the examination room before the beginning of the entry time of the examination room.
- In principle, if applicants arrive more than twenty minutes late after the examination start time (in case of an individual interview, the appointed time passed), they are not allowed to take all subjects after arrival. However, if late arrivals are due to any transportation delays, taking examinations is approved if applicants can submit certificates of delay issued by transportation companies. (If applicants arrive late by using their own cars, they are not allowed to take examinations.)
- During the examination, applicants can put only writing materials (HB black pencils, mechanical pencils, plastic erasers), a mobile pencil sharpener, a watch (which does not have functions of dictionaries, calculation and communication tools), and glasses on their desk. Applicants must not set the alarm on their watches. A stopwatch may only be used as a watch, but is not allowed to be used if it produces any sounds. Proctors may check the items if it is difficult to determine whether they have dictionary or calculation/communication functions.
- There may be no clocks in the examination room. Also the time management of the examination is conducted by proctors' watch.
- If applicants wish to use their handkerchiefs and tissues, they are allowed to use them. However, please take tissues out of packets and put them on the desk. They are also allowed to wear a lap robe without asking permission from proctors.
- During the examination, please make sure to switch off any instruments such as smartphones, mobile phones, wearable devices and any other instruments which produce sounds after releasing their alarms, and put them inside bags. Even if applicants are requested to refrain from taking the examination due to the above described reasons, IUHW will neither conduct an additional examination nor refund the application fee.

•Applicants who have physical disabilities

If applicants have any diseases or physical disabilities, please contact the Admissions Office **at least 10 days before the first day of the application period** and make sure to confirm whether they need special assistance for taking the examination as well as cautions for studying at the school.
