INTERNATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH AND WELFARE

IUHW was founded in 1995 as the first comprehensive university of health and welfare in Japan. In the academic year 2020, approximately 10,000 students are enrolled in the 11 schools and 26 departments on 6 campuses located in Otawara City(Tochigi Prefecture), Narita City (Chiba Prefecture), Minato City (Tokyo Metropolitan) ,Odawara City(Kanagawa Prefecture), Fukuoka City and Okawa City(Fukuoka Prefecture).

1 Enrollment Capacity

2 Eligibility for International Students

Applicants must satisfy all the following requirements.

- ▶ Neither have Japanese nationality nor permanent residential status in Japan
- ▶ Be able to obtain residence permits for "Student" status by the time of enrollment
- ▶ Either have completed 12 years of school education outside Japan or satisfy equivalent conditions
- ▶ Have adequate proficiency of English (preferably TOEFL iBT 80+ or IELTS 6.0+)
